

Meeting of April 20th, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8.01 pm. Roll call- present were Mayor Irwin, Councilmen Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger and Stefani. Also present were Supt. Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of previous meeting was read and approved.

Communications; letters from the following were read; Planning Commission relating to curbs and sidewalks clarification and possibility of city manager form of government- State Highway Dept relating to banners across Highway during Centennial- Water Committee reports- Councilman Pond re istering a absentee vote on the water and employee insurance issues.

Treasurer Johnson made his quarterly report. Beck moved that the Treasurers report be accepted subject to audit by Finance Committee, 2nd by H. Giger and motion was carried.

H. Melby from St Paul appeared and stated that he had for sale a used 100,000 gallon storage tank. He was notified that if the city buys a storage tank of that capacity he would be notified of the bid proposal.

Discussion was held on letter from Planning Commission but no definite action taken.

Beck moved that the city assume responsibility of Centennial Commission to place the banners across highway. Stefani 2nd and motion was carried.

After lengthy discussion on recommendations of Water Committee, Beck moved that recommendation of Water Committee at this time be rejected. H. Giger 2nd. Motion carried with V. Giger and Stefani sustaining.

H. Giger moved that attorney be instructed to draw up an ordinance amending Ordinance # 315 that all charges on water users be raised .50 monthly effective July 1st, 1959. Eversole 2nd and motion was carried.

Stefani moved to rescind the motion of the council of March 16th, 1959 to change the employee hospital insurance from National Insurance Co. to Blue Cross, Beck 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt Dunn stated that the Clackamas County Board of Health has stated that they would spray the city parks and streets for a nominal fee. H. Giger moved to accept the proposition of the Clackamas County Board of Health on mosquito control. Stefani 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt Dunn asked permission to complete wiring and toilet facilities in New Equipment Bldg. Beck moved that wiring be taken care of by Supt Dunn providing it stays under \$500.00 limitation. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Eversole moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by H. Giger and motion was carried.
