

Regular meeting of June 16th, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8.10 pm. All councilmen present except Pand. Also present was Att. Bettis, Supt. Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of June 2nd meeting was approved as mailed.

Communications read by Recorder. Letter from SR Jenkins relative to extension of time to hook up to sewerage system. Verbal communication to Recorder and relayed to council that the garbage dump is infested with rats and Bob Torgeson refuses to do anything about it.

Anderson stated that he will contact Torgeson about this matter.

The Budget Committee for 1958-59 was presented and then took over the meeting, relative to the 1958-59 budget. The Committee read proposed budget item by item that was originally approved and some changes recommended by City Recorder. After passing the 1958-59 budget, the Budget Committee adjourned at 11.12 pm. and the Council then took up its regular business.

The Council read and discussed Supt. Dums proposed plan for Sewer Project #4 as to cost-financing etc. Supt Dunn gave detailed report and explained the reason for the higher cost of \$3.72 per lineal foot, over the previous cost of Projects # 1 & 3, of \$2.36 per lineal foot.

Oathes moved that Supt Dums report to the Council dated June 16th, 1958, relative to Gentry's proposed Sewer District #1; be approved as submitted, and that the City Recorder publish a notice as required by Ordinance #395, and that a public hearing for remonstrances be scheduled for July 7, 1958 at the City Hall at 8 pm. W. Giger 2nd and the motion was carried.

Beck moved that the Council accept Budget as presented by Budget Committee with the changes noted. Anderson 2nd and motion was carried.

Att. Bettis read letter from Att. Beckett, relative to the City buying water from Noil Thompson and after considerable discussion on the conditions specified, Oathes moved that Att. Bettis notify Att. Beckett that the city is no longer interested in buying water from Mr. Thompson, due to excessive cost. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder was instructed to write to Mr. Jenkins stating the council has granted him a 90 day extension of time to hook to the sewerage system.

Beck moved that action of Ordinance # 416 be postponed until the next regular meeting, H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

H. Giger moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Beck and motion was carried.

Meeting adjourned at 12.05 a.m.
