The committee is to meet at 9 pm Honday, July 28th with Meal Thompson to talk over final terms. Committee in the meantime to look into cost of renting pipe and punp.

A special council meeting is also to be held inmediately after this meeting.

Book moved that Supt. Durn be authorized to proceed immediately with the energency hookup with Neal Thompsons water supply. H. Giger 2nd na d motion was carried.

Recordor was instructed to inform the city residents by all possible noses that water could be used from 6 to 8 pm Sunday, July 27th.

He Gigor moved that meeting be adjourned. Anderson 2nd and motion was carried.
