

Special meeting of July 28th, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by President Anderson at 9.05 pm. All councilmen present except Beck and Bond. Also present- Att. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, Recorder Lawrence and Neal Thompson.

Supt Dunn read figures given to him by Councilman Beck via phone earlier. He stated that 2% of original investment per month was standard procedure for renting equipment. Neal Thompsons investment was \$12,000.00

Mr. Beckett, attorney for Neal Thompson arrived at meeting.

After considerable discussion, it was agreed verbally between the council and Neal Thompson, that the city will pay Mr. Thompson .09 cents per 100 cuft for water used, based on the figures received from R.H. Wade & Co, as to the pumps efficiency. 2% of investment month of \$12,000.00, maintain and repair equipment. Contract is to run for 60 days with the city having the option of renewing 10 days on or before expiration, for another 30 days. Att. Bettis and Att. Beckett to draw up contract and that with a resolution to be presented to the council at its next regular meeting on August 4th.

H. Giger moved that meeting be adjourned. 2nd by V. Giger and was then carried.

Meeting adjourned at 10.28 pm.
