Giger moved that council accept Hayors appointments for Planning Commission. H. Cigor 2nd and notion was carried. Recorder was instructed to inform them by letter.

Recorder was instructed to answer San Arandsens letters to the Editor that appeared in the Canby Herald, point by point if possible.
