

REGULAR MEETING OF Sept. 2, 1958.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Dedman. Roll call; Present Mayor Dedman, Councilmen Anderson, Beck, H. Giger, V. Giger and Oathes. Also present were Att. Bettis, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Watkins Products salesman appeared asking for post/af years license to solicit in city. Was informed that he would have to pay for it either by day or week.

Fire Chief Christianson read ambulance and fire reports.

Recorder read communications: letters from Civil Defense Agency, Planning Commission, John Hart for trailer permit, School Dist. 86 C on sewer and So Pas RR. on pole yard.

W. Haworth appeared relative to 1958-59 insurance policy. After discussion as to rates, coverage etc, Beck moved that city accept insurance policy as written and pay premium. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried. Oathes moved that city insure new fire truck with binder until next meeting. Beck 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder read Records Court report.

Anderson left meeting.

Council inspected all claims for August.

Oathes moved that contract with Friden Co for yearly fee be cancelled. V. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Beck moved that bills be allowed and checks drawn on treasury. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried, by roll call vote. 4 ayes, no nays.

Council again inspected bids for equipment bldg. Supt Dunn recommended lowest bids for all steel bldg.

H. Giger moved that council accept suggestion of Supt Dunn for bid of \$6131.00 from Arneo Steel Co., Beck 2nd, Roll call, 4 ayes no nays.

Beck moved that bid bonds of Roso City Pre-Cut Bldg Co and Stevenson & Hickman be returned. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

H. Giger moved that trailer permit for Jack Hart for six months be permitted. Beck 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt Dunn and Beck spoke on their discussions with engineering firms, in relation to a pamphlet on water situation. Dunn stated that cost from Cunningham & Co will be approximately \$300.00 and Beck stated that cost of Carl Green will range from \$400.00 to \$800.00. Both firms are to submit their plans in writing before next meeting.

Supt Dunn and Att. Bettis spoke on the agreement with Mrs Jacobs. They stated that she would not sign agreement for destroying two buildings as she wants to keep one. Mr. Decker appeared and stated that these buildings were a fire hazard to his home. After discussion, V. Giger is to discuss this matter with Mrs Jacobs.
