

Regular meeting of October 6, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8.03 pm. Roll call; present were Mayor Dedman, Councilmen Anderson, H. Giger, Oathes and Pond. Also present were Att. Bettis, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of last regular meeting and special meeting were read and approved.

Roger Derr, CPA, appeared and made his 1957-1958 audit report.  
H. Giger moved that auditors report be accepted and placed on file. Oathes 2nd and motion was carried.

N. Christensen made Fire Dept. and Ambulance reports.

Communications read; W. Stevens declining nomination for city councilman- trailer permit for Edwin H. Doty and wife- National Hospital Assn relating to raising of rates- Planning Commission relating to fire hydrants and acquiring titles on city streets on So. Birch and So. Fir- Methodist Church on sewer hook up extension of time.

Mayor Dedman appointed Oathes, Pond and Recorder Lawrence on committee to investigate hospital insurance for employees.

H. Giger moved that Att. Bettis be instructed to proceed to clear titles on city properties on So. Birch and So. Fir. Oathes 2nd and motion was carried.

Anderson moved that two fire hydrants be installed at Grade School according to recommendation of Planning Commission, subject to approval of Councilman Beck. Pond 2nd and motion was carried.

H. Giger moved that trailer permit to Mr. & Mrs E Doty be issued for six months. Anderson 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt. Dunn was instructed to sign complaints against L. Bair & SR Jenkins for not connecting to sewer.

Recorder read Recorders Court report.

H. Giger moved that bills be paid except bill of Yoder for cemetery labor. Anderson 2nd and motion was passed by roll call vote. 4 ayes, no nays.

Att. Bettis read letter that he had wrote to Neal Thompsons attorney, Mr. Beckett. Recorder was instructed to write to Mr. Thompson releasing pipe and stating that the next months rent for pipe would be forwarded when due.

Att. Bettis read letter that he had wrote to Mr. Biggs, relating to Sewer District #4, regarding his opinion on assessing Pioneer Cemetery and street crossings. ( Opinion 3-58).

Anderson spoke on city renting city grader to property owners on Ferry Road for sidewalk construction. Decision of council was not to rent any city equipment to individual property owners.

Oathes spoke on city keeping records in each piece of equipment of oil changes, repairs etc. Supt Dunn is to investigate.

H. Giger moved that meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Pond and motion was carried.
