

SPECIAL MEETING OF OCT. 13th FOR OPENING OF SEWER BIDS.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Anderson. Roll call, present were Anderson, Beck, V. Giger and Pond.

Anderson stated that bids were now closed and council will proceed to open all bids.

(Mayor Dedman arrived shortly thereafter and took over chair.)

Recorder opened bids and read break downs and totals. Total bids were as follows; Geo. W. Lind, \$16,659.40, Paul Farneding 15,456.50, System Const. Co. 12,840.55, James G. Robertson \$15,383.75, Zuber Brothers \$23,531.59, Abrams Const. Co. \$13,084.50 and A.L. & A. Contractors \$15,061.70.

Att. Bettis stated that there should be a complete understanding between the city and System Const. Co. before bid should be accepted and then read their financial statement and past performances. System Const. Co stated that they had read the specifications carefully and fully understood them except for matter of re-blacktopping street at High School. Supt Dunn stated that it was the citys responsibility for that item.

Beck moved that bid of System Const. Co. be accepted for \$12,840.55 and to be completed in 45 days and that Ma-yor be authorized to execute contract. Anderson 2nd and roll call vote was taken with 4 ayes and no nays.

Att. Bettis then spoke on correspondence with Geo. W. Lind on Sewer Treatment Plant repairs, and their offer of settlement.


V. Giger moved that city accept offer of Geo. W. Lind of October 4th, of \$445.00 for full settlement of citys claim on repairs for Sewer Treatment Plant. Anderson 2nd and motion was carried.

Discussion was held on Everhart & Kent and Yoder not cooperating on administering Ord. 416. Recorder stated that he is not receiving sufficient information on burials. It was felt that they should cooperate more closely.

Pond moved that meeting be adjourned, 2nd by V. Giger and motion was carried.

Meeting adjourned at 9.55 pm.
