REGULAR LEETING OF OCTOBER 20th, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at S.O. p.m. Roll call; present-Mayor Dodman, Councilmon Anderson, Beck, V. Giger and Oathes.

Hingbes of previous meeting and special meeting of October 13th was read and approved.

H. Giger arrived at meeting.

Communications; Lotter from Fleyd Jerman on sale of pipe to city- Hiway Market on application for bear license.

Book moved that appliestion for beer license for 1959 for the Hiway Marijet be approved, Oethes 2nd and motion was carried.

Treasurer Johnson stated that there was a few small errors in distribution of funds on the published pressurers report and the suditors report and asked if it was, neessary to re-publish. Councils decision that it was not.

Larry Bair appeared and asked for 6 months extension of time to connect to the sever. due to financial struction. Mayor Dodman stated that the council would make a docision later.

Mr. Burthn of John Cummingham & Associates appeared and spoke on their report of the city a water situation. After discussion between the council, Mr San Amundson and Mr. Burden, Mr. Buidin was asked to write a letter to the city giving cost estimates for storage tanks, treatment plants etc. After this letter is received the water committee is to work up the final wording of a phomphlet and to have it printed bfore October 31st. Beek is to have full authority on its contents.

H. Giger moved that city pay Floyd Jermon \$28.67 for 3 lengths of 2" galvanized pipe. Beck and and motion was carried.

Recorder stated that Mrs Atkins had asked him if her property abutting Washington St could be in Sever District # 4. Beck moved that the Atkins property on Washington St. be added to the assessment area of Sower District # 4 if feasible. Oathes 2nd and notion was carried.

After Recorder spoke on coming elections, council gave him authority to hire separate counting beard if necessary at the same hourly rate of wages that the county pays.

Recorder and H. Giger spoke on Fire Ins. for Fire Hall relating to prices, coverage sto. Decision was to postpone it until next meeting and meanwhile H. Giger and Dumm is to investigato.

Recorder read perties of minutes of Oct. 3, 1955 meeting relating to duties of Sexten of complety and after discussion it was felt by .11 that the present committee should get together and draw up a new set of rules, etc. for the Sexten.

After some discussion as to some property owners who have not hooked up to the sewer, Supt. Durn is to be instructed to notify council all these who have not hooked up, and that once a complaint is signed against such owners, the council should not withdraw such complaint, and that the Recorders Court was the proper place for any further actions .

H. Giger moved that meeting be adjourned. 2nd by Beck and motion was carried.
