

REGULAR MEETING OF OCTOBER 20th, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8.04 p.m. Roll call; present- Mayor Dedman, Councilmen Anderson, Beck, V. Giger and Oathes.

Minutes of previous meeting and special meeting of October 13th was read and approved.

H. Giger arrived at meeting.

Communications; Letter from Floyd Jerman on sale of pipe to city- Hiway Market on application for beer license.

Beck moved that application for beer license for 1959 for the Hiway Market be approved, Oathes 2nd and motion was carried.

Treasurer Johnson stated that there was a few small errors in distribution of funds on the published treasurers report and the auditors report and asked if it was necessary to re-publish. Councils decision that it was not.

Larry Beck appeared and asked for 6 months extension of time to connect to the sewer, due to financial situation. Mayor Dedman stated that the council would make a decision later.

Mr. Burdett of John Cunningham & Associates appeared and spoke on their report of the city's water situation. After discussion between the council, Mr Sam Amundsen and Mr. Burdett, Mr. Burdett was asked to write a letter to the city giving cost estimates for storage tanks, treatment plants etc. After this letter is received the water committee is to work up the final wording of a pamphlet and to have it printed before October 31st. Beck is to have full authority on its contents.

H. Giger moved that city pay Floyd Jerman \$28.67 for 3 lengths of 2" galvanized pipe. Beck 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder stated that Mrs Atkins had asked him if her property abutting Washington St could be in Sewer District #4.

Beck moved that the Atkins property on Washington St. be added to the assessment area of Sewer District #4 if feasible. Oathes 2nd and motion was carried.

After Recorder spoke on coming elections, council gave him authority to hire separate counting board if necessary at the same hourly rate of wages that the county pays.

Recorder and H. Giger spoke on Fire Ins. for Fire Hall relating to prices, coverage etc. Decision was to postpone it until next meeting and meanwhile H. Giger and Dunn is to investigate.


Recorder read portion of minutes of Oct. 3, 1955 meeting relating to duties of Sexton of cemetery and after discussion it was felt by all that the present committee should get together and draw up a new set of rules, etc. for the Sexton.

After some discussion as to some property owners who have not hooked up to the sewer, Supt. Dunn is to be instructed to notify council all those who have not hooked up, and that once a complaint is signed against such owners, the council should not withdraw such complaint, and that the Records Court was the proper place for any further action.

H. Giger moved that meeting be adjourned. 2nd by Beck and motion was carried.

Meeting adjourned at 11.10 pm.
