

REGULAR MEETING OF NOVEMBER 17th, 1958.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8.05 pm. Roll call; Present Mayor Dedman, Councilmen Beck, H. Giger, Oathes and Pond. Also present were Att. Bettis and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of previous meeting and special meeting for canvassing of votes were read and approved.

Communications: Letter from Planning Commission and application from Rose Cafe for Beer license were read,

Recorder was instructed to inform Planning Commission that the matter of triangle at Knights Bridge Rd and Ferry Rd, was referred to the Park Committee.

Oathes moved that the application for beer license for the Rose Cafe be approved. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Treasurer read his quarterly report.

Beck moved that treasurers report be accepted subject to audit by Finance Committee. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder stated that he had checked cemetery rates for holidays at Funeral Home in Oregon City and that they stated that Oregon City and Portland Cemeteries do not have burials on Saturday afternoons, Sundays or Holidays. Saturday morning burial cost \$20.00 extra.

Pond moved that Paragraph 3 of Cemetery Committees report on duties of Sexton be amended to read "and twenty dollars for Sundays and Holidays". Oathes 2nd and motion was carried.

Beck moved that Recorder be instructed to write to County Court that Council endorses William Haworth for a term on the Clackamas County Fair Board. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Neal Thompson appeared in regards to claim from R.M. Wade & Co. for repairs to his well and crop damage due to laying of pipe. Attorney Bettis stated that he had not been able to contact Mr. Thompsons attorney Mr. Beckett on this subject. Mr. Thompson stated that he would check further with Mr. Beckett.


Att. Bettis read Ordinance # 420( special permit for sewer in case of Tatro, Schiedel and Atkins) on its first reading.

Beck moved that Ordinance #420 be accepted on its first reading and posted in 3 conspicuous places for the required length of time. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Beck moved that meeting be adjourned. 2nd by H. Giger and motion was carried.
