## Special Meeting for Budget Discussion. April 14, 1958

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8:10 pm, April 14, 1958 Roll call. All councilmen present except Beck. Att. Bettis was also absent.

kecorder and council discussed changes in item classification and council approved the following:

It is requested that the following changes be made in the preparation of the 1958-59 budget items:

- 1. Delete items "Social Security taxes, Hospital Insurance and Industrial Accident Insurance," and replace with one item called "Employees Fringe Expenses".
- 2. Delete item "Tools & Equipment" and replace with item called "Capital Expenditures", which will be used for Tools and Equipment, Buildings, improvements etc.
- 3. Add item "Emergency Fund" which will be all funds in bank, and not appropriated in budget.
- 4. General Fund. Delete items "Utility Man", "Fuel & Lights", and substitute item called "City Hall Maintenance", which will be the cost of fuel, Elect. Janitor, Janitor Supplies, Etc.
- 5. Street Fund. Insert new item called "Employees Fringe Expenses".
- 6. Sewer Fund. Insert new items as follows: Revenue; "Bancroft Bond payments and interest", Expenditures; "Supts. Salary", Bookkeeping & Office Expense". Bancroft Bonds Payments and interest." "Att. Fees".
- 7. Fire Dept. Delete item "Sinking Fund" and substitute" Repay loan to \_\_\_\_\_\_".

After discussion the council approved the recommendations of the Recorder as follows:

The following recommendations are made from this office for 1958-59 budget.

- 1. Increase Planning Commission budget overall by \$650.00 will allow sufficient funds for this year to meet the Federal Matching Funds.
- 2. Cemetary Fund. Increase cost of graves. There should be more working capital in this Fund.
- 3. Water Fund. Increase monthly charges to General Fund from \$55.00 to at least \$75.00 to defray cost of Janitor, Elect. Etc. in City Hall.
- 4. Light Fund. Increase rent charges from #75.00 monthly to at least #150.00 to defray expenses of Janitor, Elect. etc. in City Hall.
- 5. Budget sufficient funds to improve interior of City Hall, especially the Library, such as painting, floors and new entrance to basement. Recommended \$1500.00 for this.
- 6. Ceneral Fund should carry most of cost of Street Lights (Approx. 1/2 (\$3000.00) balance of cost (\$1500.00) could be charged equally between Water, Streets and Sewer.
- 7. New equipment Bldg. cost to be charged one half to Light Dept, and the remainder of cost, charged equally between the Water, Street and Sewer Dept. over a five year loan at  $2\frac{1}{2}$ % interest to the Light Dept.

Anderson moved that meeting be adjourned, 2nd by H. Giger and motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 10:15 pm.

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
