

Special Meeting 5-13-1957

Mayor Dedman announced this as an (unofficial meeting) of the Council to prepare figures to present to the 1957-58 Budget meeting to be held at a later date.

The meeting was called to order at 8.10 P.M. with the following in attendance : The Mayor, Supt. Dunn and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Howard Giger, Oathes and Pond.

In the absense of the Recorder, Supt. Dunn kept notes of the meeting.

Before proceeding with budget matters, the Council listened to Richard Stefferson, who submitted a proposition relative to the operation of a concession stand at the Molalla River park site.

Stefferson proposed to police the Park, do maintenance work, etc. for the privilege of operating a stand for the period of five years.

After considerable discussion, any action was deferred to the next regular meeting to be held on May 20.

The Council then continued with the business in hand and adjourned at 11.15 P.M.
