

Special Meeting
Friday, May 31-1957

The Council met in special session on Monday, May 31 and was called to order at 12.10 P.M. with the following present:

Mayor Dedman, Atty. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Howard Giger, Virgil Giger and Pond.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of taking action relative to sewer crossings on 99E Highway.

After discussion, it was moved by Pond, seconded by H. Giger and carried, that Atty. Bettis, in conjunction with the City Engineer and the consulting engineers, be authorized to negotiate with Hanning & Gonzales, a contract relative to boring for sewer crossings on 99E Highway at the Larry Hill service station and the Buchanan-Cellers elevator. Roll call-Yeas 4, nays 0.

It was then moved by Anderson, seconded by H. Giger and carried, that the action of the Council on May 20, 1957, relative to the use of gravel, in re-servicing pavement on South 2nd and 3rd. avenues, be rescinded.

On motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
