

Special Meeting  
Wed. Jun 5-1957

A special meeting of the Council was held immediately after its joint meeting with the Budget Committee and was called to order at 11.50 P.M.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was being held for the purpose of taking action on the budget as set up for the fiscal year July 1-1957 to July 1-1958 ; also for any other business that might properly be presented.

Present: Mayor Dedman, Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Howard Giger, Virgil Giger and Pond. Absent, Oathes.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by H. Giger and carried, that the budget as prepared for the coming fiscal year, be approved and ordered published in two weekly issues of the Canby Herald, in accordance with legal requirements. On roll call-Yeas 5-Nays 0 .

The Mayor then stated that, with the approval of the Council, she would designate Monday, July 8 at 8 o'clock P.M. in the City Hall as the time and place for a public hearing ; at which time the budget will be discussed with the City Council, which constitutes the levying board, and any person shall have the privilege of speaking in favor or against said budget.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by H. Giger and carried, that the Haworth Insurance bill of \$ 546.30 in connection with the five year plan of insurance, previously approved, be allowed and warrant ordered drawn. On roll call-Yeas 5-nays 0 .

Whereupon the matter of surveying and map of the Rasmussen tract was then discussed for the enlightenment of Councilman Anderson, who had missed the previous meeting. (no action) .

Whereupon, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned. Time 12.20
