

REGULAR MEETING SEPTEMBER 3rd, 1957.

At 8.07 pm meeting called to order by Council President Anderson. Roll call taken, Mayor Dedman absent. Councilman Beck, H Giger, V Giger Oathes and Pond, Supt Dunn, Recorder Lawrence, Fire Chief Christiansen present.

Claims against city inspected by council. H. Giger moved that bills be paid with the following exceptions; Brewer Pest Control claim for monthly remittance of \$10.00, to be sent with a letter, copy to Torgeson stating that hereafter, Torgeson is responsible for rat control at city dump. Johnson Instrument Co claim for repairs to city survey instruments be held up until invoice giving the details of their claim. Beck 2nd motion. Roll call vote. 5 ayes, no nays.

Discussion of bill of Ron Tatone. Beck moved, 2nd by H Giger that council agrees to pay claim to Ron Tatone, when John Rasmussen agrees in writing that he will make street improvements on SW 2nd Extended, subject to approval by City Superintendent. Motion carried.

Communication from Cornell, Hgyes, Howland and Merryfield read by council. Beck made motion, 2nd by Oathes that council would rather stay on 6% agreement, than change to new proposal on any future agreement. Motion carried.

Letter from Physicians Assn of Clackamas County read by recorder. After some discussion, Recorder to send letter to that Assn asking for information as to whom had withdrawn from the NHA Assn, and why the Physicians Assn did not furnish information that the council asked for originally.

Recorder gave the Cemetery and Municipal Court reports.

Fire Chief Christiansen made Fire Dept report.

Chief of Police Younce gave police report.

Recorder asked council for permission to purchase a adding machine for his office. A new General cost \$170.00, a new Burroughs \$300.00 and a 2nd hand Burroughs approx \$225.00. Beck made motion, 2nd by Pond that the city purchase a new General, and that its purchase price be taken from different funds. Motion carried.

Beck and Supt. Dunn gave report on City water test. No action taken.

V. Giger made motion to adjourn, 2nd by Oathes, Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 10.50 PM.
