

Recessed meeting of Nov 18th.

At 8. 10 pm the meeting was called to order by Mayor Dedman. Roll call, present; Mayor Dedman, Councilman Anderson, Beck, H. Giger, Oathes and Pond. Absent V. Giger.

Letter from Planning Commission asking for approval for the City Supt to supervise preparation for a base map for the city.

Supt Dunn stated that map will cost approximately \$150.00

Oathes moved, 2nd by Beck that the city prepare a base map for the Planning Commission, and that Planning Commission be authorized to make application to the State of Oregon for Federal assistance, subject to approval of the council. Motion carried.

Subject of office personnel discussed. Mayor Dedman stated that Mrs Decker had notified her Monday night at approximately 1 am that she was resigning her position. Recorder Lawrence stated that the other two office personnel had not shown up for work since Monday, and that he had hired two experienced bookkeepers for \$300.00 per month each, to take their places.

H. Giger moved, 2nd by Beck that the former office personnel be allowed their wages and Mrs Decker one weeks vacation pay, and that they be paid immediately. Motion carried.

Anderson spoke on buying a 2nd hand gravel truck for \$100.00 for the city. H. Giger moved, 2nd by Beck that the city purchase the 1946 Ford gravel truck for \$100.00. Motion carried.

Beck moved, 2nd by Anderson that the services of Doris Wilbourn and Elaine Graham be terminated Tuesday morning Nov. 19th due to the fact that they did not show up for work, and that their checks shall carry a notice of this act. Motion carried.

Subject of vault door discussed.

Pond Moved, 2nd by Oathes that Recorder be authorized to purchase a one hour Fire Proof Mosler safe door. Motion carried.

Beck moved, 2nd by Anderson that Supt Dunn be instructed to draw up specifications and plans for setting of vault door and 2 walls, necessary for forming a vault in existing jail and ask for bids from local contractors. Motion carried.

Recorder was instructed to look into buying a cash register.

H. Giger moved, 2nd by Anderson that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 9.30 pm.
