

Recessed meeting of Dec. 16th. 1957.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Dedman at 8.10 pm. Roll call  $\frac{1}{2}$  Councilmen Anderson, Beck, H. Giger, V. Giger, & Pond. Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Bid of Wm Schaefer for work on constructing a vault in the City Hall opened and read-by Recorder and inspected by Council.

H. Giger moved, 2nd by Pond the city accept bid of \$663.00 for vault construction of Wm Schaefer. Motion carried.

Recorder read 2nd reading of Ordinance 406.

H. Giger moved, 2nd by Anderson to accept Ordinance 406 at its final reading and that it be made part of the city records. Roll Call vote; 5 ayes, no naves.

Pond moved, 2nd by Beck that the city accept the deed from Fred S & Florence Allen and Thomas E Zeek for street purposes. Motion carried.

Recorder read letter from State Unemployment Commission relative to city employees covered under this act. Council decided not to take any action.

Beck moved, 2nd by H. Giger that the Recorder be authorized to purchase a cash register from the Rose Realty Co of Aurora for the sum of \$100.00. Motion carried.

Beck moved, 2nd by H. Giger that Supt. Dunn be authorized to erect a cashiers window at the Light and Water office. Motion carried.

The Council adjourned to the basement to inspect proposed Police and Public Works offices.

Beck moved, 2nd by V. Giger that Supt Dunn draw up plans remodeling basement and proceed with his own help when available to establish 2 offices in the basement of the City Hall. Motion carried.

H. Giger moved, 2nd by Anderson that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 9 pm.
