

Special Meeting  
Wednesday, March 20, 1957

A special meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday, March 20, 1957 and called to order at 8.10 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Dedman, Atty. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Howard Giger, Virgil Giger, and Pond.  
Absent-Beck & Oathes.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of taking final action on Ordinance No. 400, the same having been passed on first reading at the regular meeting of the Council held on March 4, 1957 and posted by the Recorder in the prescribed legal manner.

Ordinance No. 400

The above Ordinance, amending Ordinance No. 399 and correcting notice of Bancroft bond issue covering Sewer District No. 3 assessments, was read by Atty. Bettis and on motion by Howard Giger, seconded by Anderson and carried, placed on final passage and declared adopted.  
On roll call-Yeas 4-Nays 0.

Supt. Dunn then called the attention of the Council to the property on the Molalla River, recently deeded to the City by the County.

He explained that there seemed to be some difficulty in reaching the same and that it would be necessary to secure rights of way.

No action was taken except that the Street Commissioner and other members of the Council agreed to look into the matter thoroughly.

No other business appearing, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
