

Regu'ar Meeting
Monday, June 4-1956

The Council met in regular session on Monday, June 4 and was called to order at 8.15 O'clock, P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft, Oathes. The minutes of the previous meetings of May 21 and 24 were read and approved.

Before taking up the regular order of business, Mayor Eversole stated that any visitors would be heard at this time.

Whereupon Geo. Payton asked for information as to the laying out of streets in new sub-divisions and who assumed the costs.

He also stated his objections to paying the cost of paving adjacent to his property at S/W 6th. and Fir sts. and was told that the matter would receive consideration.

Communications and Petitions

Letter from Stan Skoko, County Court Commissioner, stating that the use of the County radar car would be provided to assist our police in apprehending speed violaters.

Invitation from the Aurora Centennial Committee to take part in their celebration to be held in July. (This was turned over to the Chamber of Commerce for their consideration).

A petition was then presented and read, asking for sewer installation on North Locust from Wait Avenue to the city limits and signed by various property owners in that district.

In this connection, it was moved by Oathes, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the petition be favorably accepted, subject to approval by the engineers.

Reports

Vernon White for the Police Dept. reported mileage for the Police Car for May-759, gas consumed 165.8 gals; also other activities-traffic citations, warnings, investigations, etc.

The Recorder reported 9 cases in Court resulting in fines of \$72.50 costs \$ 18.00.

Clayton Yoder, Supt. of Cemetery reported receipts of \$ 475.00 from sale of lots and openings.

Fire Chief Christiansen reported the Browning fire, loss \$ 7500 no insurance; also the shingle mill fire with estimated loss of \$ 75000, insurance \$ 30000.

Ambulance report covering the period from April 18 to May 15 showed 7 calls.

Contributions \$ 2316.50-expenses \$ 23.68, balance \$ 5231.04.

Chief Christiansen then stated that the annual firemen's convention would be held at Seaside the following week and asked for expense funds for those who would attend.

It was therefore moved by Hill, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the sum of \$ 90 be allowed for the above purpose.

Atty. Bettis reported having contacted Carl Bramer in regard to the dog situation, and who promised county assistance in the near future.

Councilman Hulbert then stated that the Lions Club desired to improve the Wait Park baseball diamond and requested the use of the City's scraper.

Whereupon, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Hill and carried, that the use of the City's equipment be allowed for improvement of the ball diamond, with the understanding that grass is not to be removed ~~and~~ the backstop^{to be} extended.

Councilman Kraft then made a few remarks relative to the use of the radar car, principally to the effect that before operating for the purpose of issuing citations to speed violaters, signs should be placed and the public well informed as to what was going on.
