

Regular Meeting  
Monday July 2-1956

The Council met in regular session on Monday, July 2 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M. by President of Council Kraft, in absence of Mayor Eversole.

Present: Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft and Oathes.

The minutes of the previous meetings of June 18 and 21 were read and approved, after some corrections.

Communications and Petitions

Petition for sewer service on North Juniper St. between Wait Avenue and Virginia Avenue was presented and on motion by Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, was approved, subject to the usual sanction by the engineers.

Also petition for sewer service on N.E. 2nd. Avenue, from No. Ivy, Northeasterly to end of street.

In connection with this, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Hulbert, that petition be returned for more than the three signers, and to read " Between N.E. First Avenue and N.E. Second Avenue to serve the area from North Ivy easterly" . Carried.

The Recorder then read a communication from the Lion's Club, thanking the Council for the use of the City roller used at the Wait Park; also asking for permission to park a concession trailer along Holly street adjacent to the Park, for the summer baseball season. A schedule of games to be played was also presented.

In connection with the concession trailer, Earl Oliver addressed the Council, strongly urging the granting of permission to park as above mentioned.

Council Beck explained the rule not to allow vehicles to park on streets for any extended time, and if allowed in this case, it would be unfair to others asking for a like privilege.

City Atty. Bettis also stated that under the City's ordinance such privilege could not be granted for extended time.

After lengthy discussion, it was suggested that the Lion's Club ask in writing for a thirty day privilege.

Reports

The report of City Treasurer Johnson was presented and read and on motion, seconded and carried, accepted, subject to approval by the Finance Committee.

Fire Chief Christiansen reported on but one fire call -June 21, no damage. Also interesting report of annual convention recently held at Seaside.

Ambulance report showed 20 calls from May 18 to June 17 and the following financial figures: May 15 to June 17.

The resignation of Officer Vernon White was then presented to the Council and on motion by Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, declared accepted.

The application of Loyd Younce for the office of Chief of Police was then read and the following action taken:

Moved by Hill, seconded by Anderson and carried, that Loyd Younce be appointed Chief of Police at a salary of \$ 325 per month; that he use his own judgment as to working hours, but subject to call at any time.

It was then moved by Hulbert, seconded by Oathes and carried, that Wayne Watson be employed as a relief officer at \$ 50. per month for a day and night shift on week ends *and at other periods if agreed.*

An application was also received from Harvey E. Frankum for a police job.

Also an application from Marie Dawes for the position as typist and general office work, action on this to be delayed 30 days, applicant to be employed in the meantime.
