Monday, July 23-1956

The Council met in special session on Monday, July 23 and was called to order at 8.15 by Mayor Eversole.

Present and answering roll call: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill and Kraft.

The minutes of the meeting of July 2 were read and on motion, seconded and carried declared approved.

The Recorder also noted the fact that on Monday, July 16, the date fixed for the second regular monthly meeting, none had been held for lack of attendance, sufficient for a quorum.

#### Communications.

Letter from Mrs. Eversole, Clerk of Union High S/D No. 1, relative to a course in Vocational Education for Canby firemen.

Communication from Paul Ackerman, Principal of Canby Grade School, asking that, if possible, sewer facilities be available for the new primary building, by September 10.

From Wm. Haworth submitting bid of \$ 692.65 as an annual premium covering the present City's liability insurance program.

From ex-officer Vernon White submitting claim of \$ 132.00 for services rendered while working for Officer Virgil Kleve during the month of December, 1955 and March, 1956.

Whereupon it <sup>was</sup> moved by Beck, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the White bill, above mentioned, be consigned to the waste basket.

Mr. & Mrs. E.J. Mitchell living at 411 No. Elm St., being present then appealed to the Council, in connection with the sewer construction, to spare a certain tree in the alley in rear of their property.

They were told by the City Engineer, that care would be taken and that tree would be saved, if possible.

It then appearing that Councilman Hill wished to be relieved of his duties on the Salaries and Wages committee, the Mayor stated that he would appoint Councilman Beck in that position.

City Atty. Bettis then presented to the Council draft of proposed Ordinance No. 394, an ordinance regulating the use of sewers and drains, sewage disposal, establishing sewer service charges and various other matters pertaining to sewer installation.

After a lengthy discussion, with some suggested changes, it was remanded back to the Atty. Bettis, to be presented at a later meeting, when a larger Council attendance could be secured.

Whereupon, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting was adjourned.
