

A continuation of the August 6th. meeting was held on Wednesday, August 8th and called to order at 8.25 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft and Oathes.

The Mayor then called for the following reports, which were omitted at the previous meeting:

Fire Dept. & Ambulance

Three grass fires within the City were reported-no damage.
Three rural fires , brush and grass -no damage resulting.
Sixteen ambulance calls, between June 23 and July 15 were reported by Fire Chief Christiansen and a financial statement as follows:

Supt. Yoder for the Cemetery reported receipts from lots and openings for July-\$ 175.00.

Chief of Police Younce reported 224 gals of gas used in car and mileage 1244 ; also various activities as usual.

The Recorder reported one Court case, resulting in fine of \$ 10.00

Chief Younce also suggested that it would be advisable to have the police car overhauled at once to avoid greater expense later.

Whereupon, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the car go into the shop for necessary repairs.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Beck and carried, that the State Highway Dept. be contacted, with the idea of having a more powerful red traffic light installed at the Ivy street crossing, possibly the new type similar to one now operating in Gladstone.

ORDINANCE NO. 394

The above Ordinance, establishing regulations and rates for operation of the sewer system, was introduced, read for the first time and on motion by Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, ordered published in two issues of the Canby Herald, as provided by charter, and to come up for final action on Tuesday, Sept. 4-1956. Roll call-Yeas 6, nays 0.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Beck and carried, that the City Engineer be authorized to secure assistance in his work involving sewer assessments .

On motion, seconded and carried the meeting then adjourned.
