

Special Meeting, Wed. August 29-1956

A special meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday, August 29 and called to order at 8.20 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert and Kraft. Absent Oathes.

In the absense of the Recorder, Councilman Hulbert took notes of the proceedings of the Meeting.

Mayor Eversole announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of consulting with Engineer Chas. Bales on matters connected with the sewer installation work.

Mr. Bales explained to the Council the present conditions confronting the contractors, as to increase cost of pipe, Transite pipe having experienced one raise, with another expected by Sept. first, they were therefore asking for an allowance of .35c per foot more where using Transite.

Whereupon, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the contractors be allowed 35c per foot increase on Transite pipe, where used, provided they accept all extensions now petitioned and accepted by the Council.

On motioned, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
