

Special Meeting
Thursday, Nov. 15-1956

The Council met in special session on Thursday, November 15 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hulbert, Kraft and Pond.

Mayor Eversole announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of consulting with the City's sewer engineers and representatives from the State Board of Health, Sanitary and Plumbing sections, as to various matters in connection with the sewer installations ; also for any other business that might be presented.

Those attending the meeting with Engineer Chas. Bales were Clarence E. Cuyler, Associate Sanitary Engineer and Mr. Hagg from the Plumbing Section .

A long discussion ensued and many questions and answers, in connection with sewer activities were involved.

Among other things, Mr. Bales emphasized the liabilities of the contractors as to cleaning up jobs left in bad condition.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that the City Atty be requested to work with Supt. Dunn, in drafting an amendment to Ord. No 394 to make additions towards strengthening and clarifying the same to conform with the State Sanitary Code. Roll call-Yeas 5, nays 0 .

It was then moved by Hulbert, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the application of the Hiway Market for its State liquor license for 1957 be approved.

It was then moved by Kraft, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that his license fee, paid by Mr. Dunn for sewer connection excavations, be refunded.

On motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
