

Regular Meeting  
Monday Dec. 3-1956

The Council met in regular session on Monday, December 3 and was called to order at 8.10 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, City Atty. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hulbert, Kraft, Oathes and Pond.

The minutes of November 19 were read and approved.

Communications.

Letter from the City Planning Commission recommending <sup>accepting</sup> the offer of Earl Oliver to dedicate an extension of Wait Avenue westerly from Ferry Road.

Communication from the Oregon Committee for Hungarian Refugees, urging assistance in bringing to Oregon refugees from Russian tyranny.

Two letters from the Canby Garden Club opposing the idea of removing certain trees in Zion Cemetery.

Petition from American Legion Post No. 122, to have removed certain large Maple trees now standing in the parking strip near the Legion hall.

Invitation from Milwaukie to send a representative from Canby to attend the dedication ceremony of their new bank building.

Reports

Fire Chief Christiansen reported on fires and ambulance activities as follows:

City-Warren Lee-estimated loss \$ 4500 -insurance \$ 2500  
Rural-W. Russell dwelling-Loss \$ 2500 - Insurance not known.

Ambulance calls between dates of 10/19 and 11/15-nine times  
Financial report -Bank balance \$ 1910.89

Police Chief Younce reported mileage of 1172 miles and gas used by police car-241 gals. during November; also various investigations, arrests (8) citations, warnings, etc.

The Recorder reported 7 court cases, resulting in fines of \$ 47.00-costs \$ 11.75  
Cemetery Supt. Yoder reported-receipts for lots sold \$ 175.00 grave openings \$ 105.00

It was then bro't to the attention of the Council, that the sewer contractors, in excavating through the grounds of the Hulbert Flower Shop, had caused considerable damage, in that bulbs and plants had been destroyed or lost.

In this connection, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Oathes and carried, that the Mayor appoint a committee of three persons to appraise the damages, above mentioned and report their findings back to the Council.

It was then moved by Hulbert, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the applications of the Cutsforth Market and that of the Vinyard store, for State license to sell package beer, be approved.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by Anderson and carried, that commencing with January 1-1957 a sewer ~~assessment~~ *SINKING FUND* of .50c per month be charged against all churches in Canby.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the members of the special City counting board for the recent November election, be paid at the rate of \$1.00 per hour; also that each member of the receiving boards be paid \$ 2.00 . Roll call-Yeas 6, nays 0 .

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Beck and carried, that Mrs. Dedman be named to represent Canby at the dedication ceremonies of the new Pioneer Bank building in Milwaukie, to be held on Dec. 8.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Beck and carried, that Earl Oliver be relieved from any sewer assessment against the following described property, providing he dedicates same to the City for street purposes: an extension of Wait Avenue, 60 feet in width and extending westerly to the intersection of the extension of Washington Avenue, a distance of approximately 240 feet."
