December 6, 1956 Recess from Dec. 3-1956

The Council met on Thursday, December 6, recessed from Dec. 3, with the following present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, Supt. Dunn, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Hulbert, Kraft and Pond.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was being held for the purpose of acting on Ordinance No. 396 and any other business that might appear.

Ordinance No. 396

The above ordinance was then read by Atty. Bettis and on motion by Kraft, seconded by Anderson, declared passed on its final reading and adopted. On roll call-Yeas 4, Nays 0 .

Atty. Bettis then reported that he had examined the rules and regulations as to the required number and qualifications of employes used in operating the City's Light and Power system and found that one journeyman lineman, with the help of an apprentice would meet requirements.

It was then moved by Anderson, seconded by Pond and carried, that another electrician be employed during the absence of Jim Watkins; it was suggested that the services of Gene Cole or Willis Matthieu might be secured, both having filled in formerly.

The matter of crossing 99E with sewer lines then came up, the State Highway contract relative to same, having been received. After some consideration, it was decided that the City Attorney should study

the terms of the contract and report back at the next meeting as to his findings.

On motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
