

The first regular meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, January 3 and called to order at 8.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, City Attorney Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft. Absent Oathes.

The minutes of the previous meetings of December 5th. and 19th. were read and approved.

Mayor Eversole then called for the quarterly report of the City Treasurer, which was then presented and read by City Treasurer Johnson and on motion by Beck, seconded by Hill and carried, approved subject to audit by the Finance Com.

In Re: Recommendations of Canby City Planning Commission

Gentlemen:

As ex-officio member of the Canby City Planning Commission and acting Secretary at the regular meeting of the Commission held on December 20, 1955, I have been directed by a motion duly made, seconded, and passed before said Commission, to advise the Honorable Mayor and Council that it is the recommendation of the Planning Commission that the Council should act on the offer of Mr. Allison, as tendered through the City Engineer, and which said offer was to convey to the City ten feet of Mr. Allison's land and for the purpose of extending North Cedar Street. It was further recommended that the acceptance of Mr. Allison's tendered deed be conditioned on the receipt of a deed from the School Board of Clackamas County School District 86, conveying to the City for street purposes 50 feet of land adjacent to that offered by Mr. Allison, and which said 50 feet is presently owned by the School Board, having been acquired recently from Mr. Leland Hardisty. By the acquiring of these parcels of land, a 60 foot wide street can be opened by the City, extending North Cedar Street.

It was further recommended by the Commission that it is the Commission's recommendation that if and when the afore mentioned property is acquired, the City Council then moved without delay to vacate that portion of Elm Street and for the approximate distance of 300 feet north of the North Line of Fifth Street, and all pursuant to the formal request of the School Board submitted to the Council at an earlier date.

It then appearing that Mrs. Will Rider of 664 So. Ivy Street, who was present and had voiced a complaint that a neighbor's dog was continually disturbing the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, by barking, it was moved by Beck, seconded by Hill and carried, that a police officer call on the owner of the animal and in a friendly way, suggest that something be done about it.

Ordinance No. 393

The above Ordinance then coming up for final action, was read in its entirety by Atty. Bettis and on motion by Beck, seconded by Kraft and carried, declared passed on final reading and adopted. On roll call-Yeas 5, Nays 0, and so ordered.

It was then moved by Hill, seconded by Beck and carried, that the Mayor be authorized, when advised by the City Attorney, to place his signature on a certain easement or agreement with the Southern Pacific Co. relative to the proposed sewer installation across their right of way.

The following motion was then made by Anderson, seconded by Hulbert and carried: Moved that the City Council initiate a Sanitary Sewer Improvement project within the Canby City limits and basically in accordance with plans previously considered by the Council and as prepared by the engineering firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, and which project shall be paid for, in part, by special assessments against the property especially benefitted thereby; and that the City Engineer make a survey and written report of such proposed project and file the same with the City Recorder no later than 8 o'clock P.M., February 6, 1956, and which report shall conform to the requirements of Ordinance No. 393.
