

Regular Meeting
Monday, March 5, 1956

A regular meeting of the Council was held on Monday, March 5 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hulbert and Oathes.
Absent - Hill and Kraft.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of Febr. 20 were read and approved.

Communications

From Bob Cooke offering safe for sale, with description of same.

From Atty. Bettis quoting Oregon Statutes relative to legality of selling or carrying concealed on person, switch blade knives.

From S/D No. 1-Union High on the matter of keeping Fourth Street by the old Stefani mill free from trucks loading and unloading.

From Wm. A. Haworth relative to requirements in securing reclassification for fire insurance purposes for Canby.

Reports

Fire Chief Christiansen reported no fire calls in the City during the month-three calls in rural district with minor damages.

Also there were eight ambulance calls between Jan. 21 and Febr. 17 inc.

Ambulance financial report showed receipts of \$ 193.50, expenses of \$ 30.96, leaving balance on hand of \$ 2728.61 .

Cemetery Supt. Yoder submitted his report showing receipts from lots purchased in the sum of \$ 370.00 and from openings \$ 300.00 .

Police report signed by Officer White showed car mileage 2512 and gas consumed 311.5 gals. other usual activities.

The Recorder reported 41 convictions in his Court during the month, resulting in fines of 320.00-costs \$ 76.50-net \$ 243.50.

City Engineer Tatone reported that property owners, namely Albert Snyder and J.A. Lighthill, both being just outside the city limits had expressed a desire to be hooked up and receive electric power from the City.

After some discussion, it was left to the discretion of the light com. and engineer and with authority to act.

Engineer Tatone also suggested that a street and sidewalk program be set up in the near future.

Councilman Oathes then bro't up the matter of providing a new supply of uniforms for the two city policemen; whereupon on motion by Beck, seconded by Oathes and carried, the Police Commissioner was authorized to purchase from Nudelman Bros., necessary uniforms, the purchase price to be \$ 209.00, and delivery to be made on or before May 1st. and payment early in July of the current year.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that the City Engineer be authorized to purchase a new flag for the City Hall.
