Recessed Meeting Wedne vy, June 22-1955

The Council met on Wed. June 22 in recessed meeting from June 6 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and all Councilmen.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was being held in accordance with action taken on May 25, fixing this date for a public hearing, to listen to any objections or remonstrances to the budget as set up for the fiscal year July 1-1955 to July 1-1956- printed forms of which and notice of this meeting having been published in two issues of the Canby Herald as of June 2 and 9; also any other business that might be presented.

Whereupon, there being no voice raised in objection to said budget, the Mayor announced its adoption.

The Recorder then opened and read some eight applications for the caretaker's job at the Cemetery, it then being decided that the applicants should be interviewed by the committee who would report later.

Fire Chief Christiansen then reported having attended the convention at Rose burg together with two other members of the Fire Department. He declared the meeting to be very interesting and instructive and well worth attending.

Mayor Eversole then called to the attention of the council, the fact that new equipment for the fire department was necessary, either in the nature of a fully equipped truck, or at least a new pump installed on the old one.

Whereupon it was moved by Anderson, seconded by Oathes and carried, that the Mayor appoint a committee to take the matter under consideration and prepare specifications with the idea of asking for bids for a new pump.

Councilmen Kraft, Anderson and Beck were then appointed by Mayor Eversole to serve as such committee.

Councilman Beck reported completion of drilling well adjacent to new disposal plant, sufficient water coming in at about 250 feet depth.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that all ordinances be arranged to date, entered and properly indexed.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Beck and carried, that bids for an

addressograph machine, reconditioned by factory, be advertised in the local paper. It was also moved by Oathes, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that the Stefani bid of \$ 191.60 for laying tile in the Recorder's office be accepted, the floor to

be first put in smooth condition. Whereupon, on motion, seconded and carried, the following claims were allowed and warrants ordered drawn:
