

Regular Monthly Meeting
Monday, August 1-1955

SESSION

The Council met in regular monthly^K on Monday, August 1 and was called to order at 8 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft and Oathes.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting held on July 1 were read and approved.

Communications

Letter from Geo. Lind requesting an extension of twenty days for completion of the sewage treatment plant.

From Frank Fillpot, Land Agent concerning back taxes on Tax Lot 2, Section 5, Twp. 4 South Range 1 East, stating that at the time of foreclosure in 1939, taxes were \$ 121.83 and at this date (August 1) would be about two and one-half times the above amount.

Bids for fire pump from Roney's Inc. and the Neep Equipment Co. were then read and left for later consideration.

Mayor Eversole then stated that, with the approval of the Council, he would at this time re-appoint Gordon Weygant, Sr. as a member of the City Planning Commission for a four year term commencing this date.

Reports

Fire Chief Christiansen reported two city fire calls and two rural calls in July-grass fires with no resulting damage.

Also four ambulance calls and financial report showing bank balance of \$ 244.30.

Officer Johnson reported for police activities during July, showing mileage of 2400 and gas consumed 300.4 gals. ; also arrests, warnings, investigations, etc.

The Recorder reported 63 cases in court resulting in fines of \$ 363.00-costs \$ 90. Also three building permits issued.

Fire Chief Christiansen also reported some additional equipment needed for the Department and on motion by Hulbert, seconded by Oathes and carried, the Fire Commissioner was authorized to make necessary purchases.

Councilman Oathes reported having attended the Police Officer's Assn. meeting in Portland recently-also stated that the new set-up for police contacts seemed to be very satisfactory.

Councilman Hill for the wage and salaries committee, then submitted the following recommendations:

On motion by Kraft, seconded by Oathes and carried, the above adjustments were authorized. Roll call-Yeas 5-nays 0 .

It was then moved by Hill, seconded by Oathes and carried, that the sum of \$ 100.00 be appropriated toward street decorations for the coming County Fair.

Councilman Hulbert then stated that Bill Dolson desired parking space for taxi-cab in front of Ernie Meek's place on First Avenue.

In this connection, it was moved by Hulbert, seconded by Kraft and carried, that such zone be allowed for taxi parking and that a fee of \$ 5.00 per quarter be charged for same.

City Engineer Tatone then reported that Mr. Roderick had recently been in Canby with some revised sewer plans, although not completed; suggested that owing to the increase in Bancroft limitation, it might be well to consider more sewer districts.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Hill and carried, that the bid of the Neep Equipment Co. for a used fire pump, at the price of \$ 1178.00 be accepted. Roll call-Yeas 5-nays 0 .

It was then moved by Hill, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the bid of Abbott & Lind of \$ 685 for a Model 1955 Addressograph machine be accepted.

Atty. Bettis then read a letter from the Weyerhaeuser Co. asking for water service from the new treatment^{PLANT} well recently drilled and on motion by Oathes, seconded and carried, the City Attorney and Tatone were authorized to work out an agreement.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the Mayor be authorized to contact bidders for the work of making the annual audit of the City books and records and to make, in his opinion the most favorable arrangements.
