

Spec' l Meeting
Tuesday, Sept. 13-'55

A special meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, Sept. 13 and called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis (late 10.05), City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert and Kraft.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of considering sewerage problems, applications for the position of caretaker at the Cemetery and any other matters that might be presented.

For the cemetery job, the Council then proceeded to interview separately the following applicants: James P. McVey, Leonard A. Fuller and Clayton C. Yoder, who had been selected from other applicants and asked to appear at the meeting.

After the interviews and some discussion, it was decided to continue for a time, the present arrangement with Clayton Yoder in charge and until it could be worked out as to what remuneration would be reasonable for the position.

Sewer matters were then taken up, with Chas. Bales from Corvallis being present and Ralph Roderick appearing late in the evening.

After length discussion and examination of the plans, it was moved by Hill, seconded by Kraft and carried; That the engineers be authorized to bring up to date, specifications for new bids; these to include a line from Ivy street, west thro' 4th. st. ally and Wait Park to Grant st.; also on 4th. st. east to Locust; also inspection ^{of} High School requirements for any correction. 10/21
