

A special meeting of the Council was held on Monday, Octo. 31, having been called for the purpose of opening and considering sewer bids presented, in accordance with previously published calls.

The meeting was called to order at 8/10 P/M/ by Mayor Eversole and with all councilmen present. and Chas. Bayles

Also present were Atty Bettis, City Engineer Tatone and Ralph Roderick, consulting engineers. In the absence of the Recorder, Mrs. Decker was asked to keep a memorandum of the proceedings of the meeting.

Mayor Eversole then requested Mr. Roderick to open the bids, which were as follows:

Unit prices from the two lowest bids (A.L. & A Const. Co. and E-W- Const. Co.) were then read by Mr. Roderick, after which all bids and bonds were placed in his hands for checking and to report back to the Council at the next meeting.

A letter from the Canby Garden Club was then read, asking for permission to use the library for its annual Christmas sale of flowers, etc. on Dec. 17.

Whereupon, on motion of Beck, seconded by Hulbert and carried, the same was granted and the Recorder instructed to so advise them.

A communication from School Board of District # 86 was also received and requesting the vacation of North Elm St. from NW 5th. Avenue northerly.

Tabled for later consideration.

A letter was also received from Lee L. Hershberger, more or less criticizing the City's granting building permits, intimating that permits had been issued, which in the future might interfere with the laying out or continuance of certain streets.

This matter was referred to the City Planning Commission.

It then appearing that Workman & Wilson, contractors desired to erect a shop on SE 4th. near Knott st., City Engineer was asked to investigate the matter before permit was granted.

On motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
