#### Regular Meeting Moi y, December 5-1955

The Council met in regular session on Monday, December 5 and was called to order at 8.45 P.M. by Acting Mayor Kraft, in the absence of Mayor Eversole. Present: Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Hill, Hulbert, Kraft and Oathes.

The minutes of the previous meetings of November 7 and 21 were read and approved.

#### Communications.

Letter from E.C.Sammons, State Director for Safe-Driving Day, acknowledging and thanking the City for its cooperation, etc.

It was then moved by Anderson, seconded by Oathes, that the offer of the Portland General Electric Company of \$2298.29 for their lines thro' the City, as described in a certain bill of sale, dated Nov. 21, 1955, be accepted; also included in the same motion, that they be offered the sum of \$ 50.00 for 35 crossarms and 11150 feet of No. 4 bare hard drawn wire, it being understood that if offer is not accepted, the P.G.E. shall remove said cross arms and wire within thirty days. Carried and so ordered.

#### Reports

Fire Chief Christiansen reported one city fire in November and four rural calls with minor damages resulting; also ambulance report as follows:

Twelve calls between dates of Sept. 15-November 9. Financial report-Contributions \$ 175.00-Expenses \$ 450.58 leaving bank

balance of \$2311.17.

Cemetery Supt. Yoder reported five burials during November; also stated that he had contacted other cemeteries as to prices for lots and openings finding as follows: Oregon City has three different prices for lots, according to location-\$75.00-\$100.00-\$125.00, charge for openings \$35.00.

> Portland charges are \$ 30 for openings and various lot prices.

Police report signed by Officer White shows car mileage 2491 and gas used 343.9 🚒 gals. various arrests, assistance, warnings, etc.

The Recorder reported 26 convictions in Court during the month, resulting in fines imposed of \$ 322.00-costs \$ 72.50.

Engineer Tatone reported having received two bids on fencing material for the 2nd Avenue city propefty; Colorado Fuel & Iron Corp. \$ 2019.00 and American Steel & Wire Co. \$ 2093.00, both F.O.B.Canby.

Whereupon it was moved by Oathes, seconded by Hulbert and carried that the bid of the Colo. Fuel & Iron Copp. be accepted.

Tatone also reported one bid on  $\frac{1}{2}$  tonk pickup truck, that of the Eversole Motor Co. -\$ 1671.47 for 6 cylinder and \$ 1757.36 for an 8 cylinder truck.

Whereupon it was moved by Hulbert, seconded by Oathes and carried that the bid be not accepted.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Hill and Carried, that another call for bids be published and to be opened December 19 at 8 o'clock P.M. or soon after.

#### ORDINANCE\* No. 393

Ordinance No. 393, being an ordinance designating the procedure to be followed in making streets, sidewalks, sewer and other public improvements and in determining the amount of special assessments therefore etc. was read by Atty. Bettis and on motion by Anderson, seconded by Hulbert and carried, declared passed on its first reading, ordered posted in the required legal manner and to come up for final action at the regular meeting of the Council to be held on January 3, 1956.

It was then moved by Oathes, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the following Oregon State Liquor licenses be approved.

Walter Faist tavern- to dispense beer by the drink .

Vinyard's store -to sell package beer.

Atty. Bettis then announced that arrangements had been made to meet with the County Court on Wed., Dec. 7 for the purpose of securing a sewer easement thro' the Clackamas County Fair Grounds.
