

Recessed meeting  
Monday April 18-1955

A meeting of the Council, recessed from April 4 and called primarily for the purpose of opening and considering bids for the sewer project was held on Monday, April 18-1955.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hill, Hulbert and Oathes. Absent, Kraft.

Before calling the meeting to order, the bids were read in detail by Mr. Roderick of the engineering firm employed by the City.

Following this, most of the twenty five or so bidders, contractors and prospective sub contractors interested, left the council chamber and the meeting was officially called to order at 9.15 P.M.

After checking over the bids for the sewer lines, it appeared that the one presented by the P.S. Lord Co. was the lowest, being \$ 264689.41 .

A half dozen bids for building and equipping the treatment plant were offered, the lowest amounting to \$ 39308.00 was turned in by Gorge W. Lind.

Followed a discussion until a late hour as to the situation, the bids on the sewer lines being considerably above any estimate.

It was then decided that Mr. Roderick would take the bids and figures back to his office and after careful study, report back at the next meeting to be held on Monday, May 2.

The Recorder then read a bid from the Stefani Lumber Co. offering to furnish material and labor for floor covering in the Recorder's room for \$ 191.80.

No action was taken, as it was understood that another bid had been prepared and would be presented later by the engineer.

Mayor Eversole then stated that he would appoint to serve on the Budget Committee-Messrs. Ed. Johnson and Archie Markee in place of the two members retiring.  
( Approved by the Council.)

The Recorder then read a communication from the County Court relative to matron services in the County jail, the gist of which was as follows:

" Unless the cities of the County wish to provide their own matron services, the County Court will enter an order directing the Sheriff's Department to secure such matron services that are needed for women prisoners lodged in the County jail by the various cities of the County and to make a charge therefor at the rate of \$ 1.50 per hour".

Whereupon on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
