

Special Meeting
Wed. May 25-1955

The Council met in special session immediately following its joint meeting with the Budget Committee. Called to order at 9.45 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hulbert, Kraft and Oathes.

It was moved by Oathes, seconded by Hulbert and carried, that the budget as set up for the fiscal year-July 1-1955 to July 1-1956, be approved and published in the Canby Herald in two weekly issues. Roll call, Yeas 5-nays 0.

Mayor Eversole then stated that, with the approval of the Council, he would designate Wednesday, June 22 at 8 O'clock P.M. in the City Hall, as the time and place for a public hearing, at which time, the budget will be discussed with the City Council, who constitute the Levying Board and any person shall have the privilege of speaking in favor or against said budget.

The Recorder then read a communication from the Bonneville Power Administration, stating the the firm of Ford, Bacon and Davis had been appointed as engineers to make a detailed study of Bonneville's rate schedules and asking for Canby's co-operation in the matter.

Also a letter from the above mentioned firm requesting our assistance.

It not being quite clear as just what was expected, the Recorder was instructed to ask the B.P.A. if it would not be possible for Mr. Chas. Dunn to meet with the Council at the next regular meeting on June 6.

It was then moved by Anderson, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the City Treasurer and Atty. Bettis be authorized to reinvest the sewer bond funds in the First National Bank of Portland, Oregon City Branch, for various periods according to their judgment.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
