

Regular Monthly Meeting
Monday, Nov. 1-1954

The Council met in regular monthly meeting on Monday, Nov. 1 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Eng. Tatone, Fire Chief Christiansen, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Hill, Hulbert, Johnson and Kraft

The minutes of the previous meetings of October 4 and 6 were read and approved.

Communications

The following communications were read by the Recorder :

From Earl Oliver asking that his name be omitted from the election ballot, as a candidate for councilman .

From George Irwin and Hoy Mangus, both requesting that their names be omitted as candidates for the office of Mayor.

From the City Planning Commission recommending various matters to the Council, the same having been approved at their October 19th. regular meeting.

Reports

A report of police activities for the month was submitted by Officer Johnson read by the Recorder and placed on file.

The Recorder reported 31 cases in Court during the month, resulting in fines assessed of \$ 490.00-costs \$ 103.50.

Fire Chief Christiansen reported department called out eight times, seven in rural districts, one in City.

He also reported on ambulances calls for the period from Sept. 22 to October 8 , there being eight requests for service , financial statement for ambulance fund showing contributions of \$ 135.00, expenses \$ 1.00, bank balance \$ 2185.11.

It then appearing that the Fire Department needed some stenciling equipment and racks for hose, on motion by Hulbert, seconded by Johnson and carried, the request was approved and the matter left to the Fire Commissioner to adjust.

It was then moved by Hulbert, seconded by Johnson and carried, that the licenses of the Rose Cafe to dispense ^{beer} over the counter and that of the Hiway Market to sell package beer be approved .

Whereupon discussion ensued regarding the proposed telephone changes, eliminating local operators and in this connection, Councilman Hill agreed to contact a Pacific Tel. & Tel. engineer.

Councilman Hurlbert then mentioned the complaint of Ruby Smith as to water standing on 2nd Ave. adjacent to the C & R store. It was suggested he be informed, that the City department might do the necessary work to relieve the situation, providing the expense be assumed by the property owners; estimated cost approximately \$ 3.00 per foot.

It was then moved by Hill, seconded and carried, that the Council follow out the recommendation of the Planning Commission and vacate the northerly half of N.W. 7th. Avenue.

Also Atty Bettis was asked to examine into the powers of the Council, as to what action could be taken where an industry in the city limits becomes obnoxious to adjacent property owners. (Planning Com. request).

City Engineer Tatone then stated that he would like to purchase sweeper attachment for the grader; also oil distributor for patching work. Matter left to him and street commissioner for investigation.

It was then moved by Hurlbert, seconded by Hill and carried, that Tatone be authorized to purchase filing cabinet, cost not to exceed \$ 125.00.
