

Spec Meeting-Wed. Nov. 3, 1954

A special meeting of the City Council of Canby was held on Wednesday, Nov. 3, 1954 and called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Hill, Hulbert and Johnson.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast at the election held on Tuesday, November 2-1954, and other matters.

The Council then proceeded to canvass the record of ballots cast, which resulted as follows:
