

Recessed Meeting
Monda April 26-1954

The Council met in ~~meeting~~ recessed from April 5, 1954 and was called to order at 7.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, City Atty. Bettis, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Hulbert and Kraft. Absent-Girod and Hill.

The Mayor announced that the meeting was being held for the purpose of taking final action on Ordinances Nos. 381 and 382.

Ordinance No. 381

This Ordinance provides for a special election to be held on May 21, 1954 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Canby, for their adoption or rejection, a charter amendent authorizing a general obligation issue of bonds not to exceed \$ 165,000.00 for the construction of a sewage treatment plant and sewer.

The above ordinance was read in its entirety by City Atty. Bettis and on motion of Councilman Beck, seconded by Councilman Kraft and carried, was declared passed on final reading and declared adopted. On roll call-Yeas 4, nays none.

Ordinance No. 382.

This ordinance provides for a special election to be held on May 21, 1954 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Canby for their adoption or rejection, a charter amendment authorizing the City Council to provide the method of carrying into effect the Initiative and Referendum powers guaranteed to the people of this City by the Constitution of the State of Oregon .

The above ordinance was also read by Atty. Bettis and on motion by Councilman Hulbert, seconded by Beck and carried, was declared passed on its final reading and declared adopted. On roll call, Yeas 4-Nays None.

On motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
