

Regular Meeting
Mond: November 2-1953

The Council met in regular session on Monday, Nov. 2 and was called to order at about 8.30 P.M.

Attendance: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, City Engineer Tatone, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Girod, Hill, Hulbert and Kraft.

The minutes of the previous meeting of October 13 were read and approved.

The regular order of business was then suspended for the purpose of listening to Mr. Pickett, an electrical engineer from Corvallis.

Mr. Pickett then addressed the Council, stating his qualifications, references, etc. and in a general way presenting his ideas as to a proper procedure in appraising and evaluating the City's electric power system.

Letter from Piepinbrink and Kron, Public Accountants, explaining their methods and charges in connection with the yearly examination of the various accounts, as of June 30, 1953.

Request from Guy Fields, President of the Canby Lions Club, that the "Boys Motor Boat Club" be allowed the use of the QuonsetHut for the purpose of constructing a boat this winter.

Whereupon the application of C.C.Marks to sell package beer and that of Frank Rice, for Rose Cafe to sell by the glass, both being presented for the consideration of the Council, were, on motion, seconded and carried, approved.

It then appearing that a special telephone system for the new Fire Hall, had been advised and to be installed by the Canby Telephone Assn., on motion by Hill, seconded by Hulbert, it was voted to approve the same.

It was then moved by Hill, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the Mayor and Recorder be authorized, if necessary, to have transferred the sum of \$ 3000 from the Sewer Sinking Fund to the checking account, said amount to bear interest at the rate allowed by the bank on the Sewer account. Roll call-Yeas 5-nays 0.

No other business appearing, the meeting then adjourned.
