

Special Meeting  
Wednesday, February 4, 1953

A special meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday, February 4 and called to order at 815 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole and Councilmen Anderson, Hill, Hulbert and Kraft.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of conferring with the directors of the Rural Fire District, relative to the proposed new fire station and also any other business that might appear.

The following named comprising the full board of the Rural Fire District were present: Messrs. Brooks, Farnsworth, Gribble Rutherford and Sperb.

After a lengthy discussion agreement was reached on the kind of structure and it was decided to ask the architects to submit plans and costs of a building of the following dimensions: 50' x 80-60' x 80- 70' x 80.

Whereupon in connection with the paving of S.W. 4th. Avenue, the Recorder was instructed to write the State Highway Dept. that it seemed advisable to have the pavement extended to the curb and that the City would assume liability for the cost of the extra width over and above the 20 feet strip to be layed by the Department. Extra cost figured to be approximately \$ 3000.
