Regular Monthly Meeting M(ay, May 4-1953

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Monday, May 4, 1953 and called to order at the usual time.

Communications

Letters from Senator Howard Belton, Rep. Kenneth Goodall, Rep. Monroe Sweetland and City of Eugene all relative to House Bill No. 675. Also communication from the Canby Ministerial Association expressing appreciation and favorable comments on new city lights installed.

Mrs. W.H. Thompson then speaking for the Canby Garden Club asked if tables and benches could not be installed in Wait Park. Was told that the matter would be considered, but it hardly seemed advisable at this time to incur the expense.

Reports of Officers

Acting Police Chief Younce reported police activities for April.

Supt. Raines announced that he had received two bids for a pole trailer, one of \$ 1300 and another for \$ 1600. He was asked to have bidders send out one for inspection.

Fire Chief Yoder presented several bids on panel truck for the Fire Dept., but was requested to advertise in paper for other bids.

Whereupon the license of Cliff Marks for sale of package beer being presented to the Council, on motion, seconded and carried, it was voted tp approve the same on payment of the usual fee.

Councilman Hill then moved that Harley R. DePeel be employed in the police department on a temporary basis, the motion being seconded and it so voted.

Mayor Eversole then stated that, with the approval of the Council, he would set May 14 as a date for the budget meeting

It was then moved by Hill, seconded and carried that the same sum as in previous year be allowed the Fire Department for the members attending the annual fire convention school to be held in Eugene on the 8th. 9th. and 10th. of June. (\$125.00).
