## Special Meeting-Thursda May 14-1953

A meeting of the Council was called immediately after a session with the citizens members of the Budget Committee, with all members present.

Mayor Eversole, then with the approval of the Council set Monday, June 15-1953 at 8 o'clock P.M. in the City Hall of Canby, as the date and time for public hearing; at which time any one desiring to present objections or remonstrances would be heard.

It was then moved by Girod, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the City Attorney be instructed to draw up an ordinance (if necessary) governing vacations for city employees and to go into effect as of July1-1953, it being understood and agreed that vacations, with pay, shall be granted as follows:
