

Special Meeting
Thursday, Nov. 6-1952

The Council met in special session on Thursday, Nov. 6 and was called to order at 7.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Irwin, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Girod, Hill, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast for city officials at the recent election held on Nov. 4, and any other business that might appear.

The counting of the votes then followed and results found to be as below:
