

Special Meeting  
Wed. Jan. 23-1952

A special meeting of the City Council was held on Wednesday, January 23, 1952 and called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present and answering roll call, were Mayor Irwin, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Cutsforth, Girod, Hill and Kraft. Councilman Rupp reported later.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of discussing the matter of taking an inventory of the City property as of Jan. first, by an official of the City Government and in addition to that previously taken by city employees; also any other business that might appear.

After a lengthy discussion, Supt. Raines having been called in to take part, the following motion was presented :

Moved by Kraft and seconded by Anderson that a semi-annual inventory, as of January first and July first, of all materials, stock and equipment be taken; that said inventory be taken by an official appointed by the Council with the assistance of a city employee; that said inventory shall be perpetual and that a dozen copies be made of each. The above motion was then put to vote and carried unanimously.

The application of the Canby Auto Wreckers for a renewal license was then presented for approval of the Council and on motion, seconded and carried declared approved and the Mayor and Recorder instructed to so indicate by their signatures .

No more business being presented, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
