

Regular Monthly Meeting
Mo y, March 3, 1952

The City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 3 and was called to order by acting Mayor Kraft in the absence of Mayor Irwin.

Present: Councilmen Anderson, Cutsforth, Girod, Hill, Kraft and Rupp., Supt. Raines. Curtis Johnson, Jr. acted in the place of the Recorder, who was also absent on account of illness.

The minutes of the previous meeting of February 4 were read and approved.

Communications

From the State Highway Commission stating that a warrant for \$ 5245.88 being the amount allocated to Canby from State Highway revenues, would be mailed sometime in February.

Also from the Highway Commission to the effect that a project in Canby to be constructed from the 1952 Special City Allotment fund had been approved; this consists of grading and concrete paving on First Street north from Elm to Douglas, Douglas from 1st to 2nd., second from Douglas to Cedar and on Cedar from 2nd to 3rd.

We are to be contacted at a later date to work out details.

Another letter from the same source stating that application should be made by Sept. 1-1952 for next year, if funds are desired for the improvement of streets receiving excessive wear through sudden increase in population or heavy and unusual industrial traffic.

Letter from the office of L.P.Hopkins, S.P. superintendent stating that again orders had been issued that stock cars should be cleaned in the old gravel pit.

Also that the refuse sawdust from the sawmill was being dumped under a lease held, which gave them the permission to do so.

Reports

Fire Chief reported no calls during the month.

Police Chief submitted his usual report and asked to be allowed to purchase two pads for the jail bunks at a cost of about \$ 5.00 each.

The Recorder reported 14 cases in Court during the month, resulting in fines of \$ 192.50-costs \$ 42.50.

Whereupon Neil Thompson being present addressed the Council on behalf of the P.T.A. asking for better lighting around the grade school and also that repairs be made to street in front of the High School.

Mr. Thornton wanted to know what the Council thought about installing a pipe line in his 25 ft street in front of his house, north of grade school grounds.

In connection with this, a committee composed of Anderson, Hill and Kraft was appointed to confer with the Grade School directors with the idea of securing an additional strip of school land for the purpose of widening said street.

Mrs. Decker then asked for two weeks vacation during March, the request being granted.

The Recorder was then requested to notify by mail the committee appointed to check over the inventory report recently submitted.

Whereupon the Canby Evangelical Church having asked permission to string a banner across Ivy street, the request was granted subject to any regulations of the State Highway Commission.

The following bills and claims against the City were then presented, allowed and warrants ordered drawn. Yeas 6, nays 0.
