

A special meeting of the Council was held on the above date and called to order at 8.45 P.M.

Present: Mayor Irwin, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Cutsforth, Hill, Kraft and Rupp. Absent, Girod.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called in accordance with action taken on May 16, fixing this date for a public hearing to listen to any remonstrances or objections to the budget as set up for the year 1952-1953, and any other business that might appear.

There being no such remonstrances or objections voiced, on motion by Kraft, seconded by Hill and carried, the budget as heretofore published was declared adopted.

The Recorder then read a communication from C.E. Stewart, District Engineer for Federal Public Works service, asking for information as to the current status of the proposed sewerage construction.

Also a letter from the Oregon State Civil Defense Agency relative to the purchase of hose and other items for the fire department, whereby the Federal Government and State of Oregon will match the City's funds.

Also letter from the State Highway Department stating that contract for paving on First Avenue, Douglas st. and N. 2nd. avenue had been let to the Oregon Asphalt Paving Co. and work to be completed not later than August 31, 1952.

Letter from Bonneville relative to installation of a flood light system in the City Park.

In connection with this, Supt. Raines submitted some figures from the General Electric Supply Corporation as to cost of installing.

The matter of issuing a building permit to Mrs. Palmer, for a dwelling at the corner of N.E. 4th. Avenue and Juniper sts. then came up for discussion, it being decided that a permit could be allowed, providing her dwelling would not encroach on Juniper street if and when extended.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
