### Regul Monthly Meeting Oct -Jer 1-1951

The Council met in regular session on Monday, October 1 and was

called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Irwin, Atty. Zimmerman, Supt. Raines, Chief of Police Hudson, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Girod, Hill and Kraft. Absent-Cutsforth and Rupp.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of Sept. 4 and those of the special of Sept. 13 were read and approved.

Whereupon the Recorder read a letter from Ralph Milln stating that the County Court had as yet done nothing about the purchase of a ferry boat for use on the river north of Canby.

The Mayor then announced that the Council would now listen to any bid or bids offering to furnish a new police car to the City, a " Call for bids" having been published in two issues of the Canby Herald.

Whereupon it appearing that the bid of R.B. Eversole was the only one presented, the same was opened and read and duly considered.

It was thought, however, that it might be well to give the matter wider publication and on motion by Hill, seconded by Kraft and carried, the Recorder was instructed to re-advertise in the Portland Daily Journal of Commerce, as well as in the Canby Herald.

## Various Reports

City Treasurer Johnson submitted and read his report covering the various funds and for the quarterly period ending Sept. 30-1951, the same being accepted subject to approval by the Finance Committee.

Police Chief Hudson submitted his usual monthly report in detail. The Recorder reported six cases in his Court during the month, with

fines of \$ 60.00-costs \$ 15.00.

Fire Chief Yoder reported 7 city calls in August (no loss) and 6 calls in Sept. (losses \$ 200.00).

Rural District-9 calls in August ( no damage) and 12 in September, with no losses.

Supt. Raines reported ditch digging starting for the infiltration gallery in the Molalla River bed and pipe about to be installed. Also stated that it might be well to order more transformers, as it had been reported they might be hard to get later.

It then appearing that Larry Graham had worked for the City one year, lacking a week, when he was obliged to quit on account of injury, on motion, seconded and carried, it was voted to grant him a week's vacation

Floyd Galbraith, Supt. at the cemetery then told the Council, that if the City would purchase and own certain equipment for use at burials, a very substantial profit would accrue, which is now going to the mortuary, which at present is furnishing such equipment.

Owing to the absense of Councilman Rupp, this matter was tabled for

the present.

Councilman Kraft then reported that no desirable applications for the position of night police had yet been presented.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
