Sr lal Meeting Wed. Febr. 21-1950

The Council met in special session on Wednesday, Febr. 21 and was called to order at 8.20 P.M.

Present: Mayor Irwin. Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen
Anderson, Cutsforth, Girod, Hill, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called to consider new Bonneville contract and also proposed agreement with the Portland

General Electric Co.covering certain lines within the city limits.

The following resolution was then introduced by Girod and on motion, seconded and carried, declared adopted, with the understanding that the metter of increasing the capital investment of the light department on the city's books be considered by Bonneville:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mayor and Recorder be instructed to execute and sign the new contract (also supplemental agreement) between the Bonneville Power Administration and the City of Canby, under the terms of which, power will be supplied to the City under provisions of the E-4 Rate schedule.

It was then moved by Girod, seconded by Hill and carried, that the above mentioned agreement with the P.G.E. be approved and ordered signed by the Mayor and Recorder.

Mayor Irwin then broached the matter of the Sather will, having at the last meeting asked Atty. Zimmerman to secure what information was available as to the disposition of the property.

A photostat copy of the final report of the executor having been left with the Recorder, he read same to the Council.

This report showed that all liquid assets of the deceased had been

distributed to the widow and for various fees, bills and claims, leaving

nothing to cover other bequests.

It appearing to the members of the Council that a full report of all the court proceedings relating to the closing of the estate should be submitted, Mayor Irwin stated that he would contact Atty. Zimmerman

and ask him to procure this information.

There was no other business presented and the meeting then adjourned,
