

Special Meeting
Thursday, June 8-1950

The Council met in special session on Thursday, June 8 and was called to order at 8.20 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Irwin, Kraft, Porter and Rupp. Absent Beck.

The Mayor stated that the meeting had been called for the purpose of considering the new Bonneville-Canby contract, as to its relation to a Bonneville-P.G.E. contract.

Mr. Chas. Dunn of the Bonneville Power Administration and several representatives of the P.G.E. were present.

It appearing that in building it's new proposed line from West Linn to Salem, the P.G.E. Company intended to locate a sub-station south of Canby at the intersection of the Molalla and Rackleff roads, some objection was raised as to it's being too far from Cahby's apparently growing district, as well as causing the City considerable additional expense in installing feeder lines.

Mr. Dunn then suggested that if the Company should install the sub-station on the North side, just outside of the City limits adjoining the Ferry Road, in his opinion it would eliminate about two miles of expensive line building.

After a lengthy discussion, Mr. Johnson of the P.G.E. stated that his company would check the proposed new route before any decision could be made in the matter and after doing so would contact Messrs. Dunn and Raines before again meeting with the Council.
